NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2 ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 The BYOC Race Series is open to all participants who have successfully registered with National One Design sailing, have paid all relevant fees and deposits and who have either completed boat orientation and/or have previous experience on the Flying Tiger 7.5's.

3.2 Crew Requirements:

a) Minimum total of 4 crew and a maximum of 6 crew (no weight limits).

3.3 Eligible teams may enter by completing the online registration by June 15th, 2018

3.4 The following restrictions on the number of boats apply: A maximum of 10 boats participate.

4 BOATS

4.1 The event will be sailed in Flying Tiger 7.5s provided by National One Design Sailing Academy.

4.2 Boats will be provided for all competitors, who shall not modify them or cause them to be modified in any way except that

(a) a compass may be tied or taped to the hull or spars, the compass may not be capable of sending or receiving any data of any kind and shall show boat's heading only.

(b) wind indicators, including yarn or thread, may be tied or taped anywhere on the boat;

(c) hull, deck and rudder may be cleaned, but only with water;

(d) adhesive tape may be used anywhere above the gunwale.

4.3 All equipment provided with the boat for sailing purposes shall be in the boat while afloat.

4.4 The penalty for not complying with one of the above instructions will be disqualification from all races sailed in which the instruction was broken.

4.5 Competitors shall report any damage or loss of equipment, however slight, to the organizing authority's representative immediately after securing the boat ashore. The

penalty for breaking this instruction, unless the protest committee is satisfied that the competitor made a determined effort to comply, will be disqualification from the race most recently sailed.

- 4.6** Boat allocations will be decided by National One Design Sailing Academy and will be announced at the General Skippers Meeting.

5 FEES

- 5.1** Required registration fee is \$1199.00 + HST. Boats registered and paid before Nov. 15th, 2017 will receive an early registration discount with full payment of \$999.00. Registration deadline is June 15th, 2018.

- 5.2** Teams must sign and complete the “Damage Acknowledgement”. An outline of damage costs will be provided prior to the event.

6 SCHEDULE

- 6.1** A General Skippers Meeting will be held prior to commencement of the series on a date to be determined. Attendance at this meeting is mandatory.

- 6.2** Dates of racing:

June 18th, and 25th, 2018

July 2nd, 9th, 16th, 23rd, and 30th, 2018

August 6th, 13th, 20th, 27th, 2018

- 6.3** 2 races are scheduled each evening. The 2nd race will start no less than 5 minutes after the last boat finishes the first race.

- 6.4** Boats will be available for open practice on a date/or dates to be determined.

- 6.5** The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 18.30 hours each date.

- 6.6** No warning signal will be made after 19.45

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available to the competitors no later than June 15th, 2018.

8 VENUE

All racing will take place on Lake Ontario off Bronte Harbour, course location will be outlined in the Sailing Instructions.

9 BERTHING

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while they are in the harbour.

10 PRIZES

- 10.1** Prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places in the series.

11 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Sail Canada prescription rule 4, Decision to Race. National One Design Sailing Academy may, at their sole discretion, cancel racing at any given time should they so decide. Neither One Design Sailing Academy nor organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
